Sunset's Red Horizon A classic tomato—with meaty, heart-shaped fruit as big as grapefruit and sweet, full-bodied flavor—this Russian native has good texture and plenty of rich juice. It made its American debut thanks to Gary Ibsen, founder of California's Carmel TomatoFest, who honored *Sunset* with its name.

BBT Bacon Basil Tomato Sandwich Split a piece (about 3½ by 5 in.) of ciabatta bread (or a crusty roll) in half lengthwise. Toast lightly. Spread cut sides generously with mayonnaise. Cover bottom half with 4 to 6 large fresh basil leaves and a thick layer of 4 to 6 slices firm-ripe Sunset's Red Horizon or similar large tomatoes. Sprinkle with salt and fresh-ground pepper to taste. Top with 2 slices crisp-cooked bacon. Cap with top half of ciabatta (or top half of roll). Makes 1 sandwich.
